

10. CALI



Cali – was founded on 25 July 1536 by the Spanish conquistador Sebastián de Belalcázar. Cali, also known as the "Capital de la Salsa" given the city's infatuation with that type of Afro-Caribbean music. One feels the kindness of its people and appreciation of the beauty of its scenery. With a temperature of 25 degrees all year round it is a place to spend a wonderful time.

Cali - Excursions

Panoramic City Tour (approx. 4h)

Drive along the most important buildings of Cali, the Monument of Cristo Rey, the viewpoint Sebastián de Belalcazar, the Boheme Quarter, the Monument of El Gato and the historical Center part.

City Tour, Salsa & Gastronomic aspects including lunch & dinner (approx. 10h)

One of the riches of the Pacific region is the fertile soil, suitable for growing fruits, vegetables and flowers, that, along with crafts, makes this journey one of the most authentic in town. Enjoy the aromas, flavours, colours and textures of the Valle del Cauca, with a tour of the main food supply centre of Cali. Pay a visit to one of the most famous Salsa schools and take a one hour dancing class. Afterwards observe and enjoy a salsa show with the professionals. After a short brake at your hotel, experience a delicious dinner at a nice restaurant.



San Cipriano Reserve including lunch (approx. 6 -7h)

After a 2 hour drive you reach the village of Cordoba. Here you change to the "brujita", the



typical old fashion way of transportation on the Railway tracks to reach the San Cipriano Reserve. Here you start your hike, crossing small rivers, hiking through a part of jungle and freshing up at the waterfalls. To be in a region with high pluviosity, you can be sure that a refreshing rainshower hits you. In the afternoon you start returning to Cordoba, to take your drive back to Cali.



City tour & show de la Salsa (approx. 8h)

Drive along the most important buildings of Cali, the Monument of Cristo Rey, the viewpoint Sebastián de Belalcazar, the Boheme Quarter, the Monument of El Gato and the historical Center part. Now its time for your Salsa dance classes. Learn your first steps while adapting the rhythm. At night experience a real hot music evening. Enjoy a fantastic Salsa Show like the one of Delirio or Ensalsate or the Mulato Cabaret.
