



BEST OF SOUTH AMERICA

A JOURNEY THROUGH PERU, ARGENTINA AND BRAZIL

The wealth of impressive sights in South America is difficult to combine in only one journey. For our Best of South America tour we have chosen a harmonious selection of countries and highlights, even the best!

Day 1 Lima

Arrival in Lima, the capital city of Peru.

Day 2 Lima

City tour inclusive visit to the Larco Museum. This unique museum contains a large collection of pottery from Inca and pre-Inca civilizations as well as erotic art pieces. In the afternoon you may visit on optional basis the waterpark "Parque de la Exposición" including dinner.

Day 3 Lima - Cusco - Yucay

Flight to Cusco and transfer to the Sacred Valley. On the way visit to the Chinchero community and the Sunday market of Chinchero. Continue to "El Mirador de Racchi" for a splendid view of the Sacred Valley. Typical lunch at a local restaurant.

Day 4 Yucay

In the morning optional excursions like visiting Maras & Moray or trekking to the terraces of Yucay may be done. In the afternoon visit to the ruins of Ollantaytambo.

Day 5 Yucay - Machu Picchu - Cusco

Full day excursion by Vistadome train to visit the Incan site of Machu Picchu. Enjoy a guided visit of around 2 hours of the ruins and return by bus and train to Ollantaytambo station. Transfer to your hotel in Cusco.

Day 6 Cusco

The contrasts of indigenous styles and the modern western world give this city its rare beauty. Half day city tour including a visit of the ruins around Cusco, e.g. Sacsayhuaman.

Day 7 Cusco - Puno

Overland transfer to Puno on the shores of magnificent Lake Titicaca (on shared basis). On the way visit Andahuaylillas with its Sistine Chapel of America, the temple of Wiracocha in Racchi and Puka Pukara en route inclusive lunch.

Day 8 Puno - Lima

Day tour to the islands of Uros and the unique culture of the Taquile Island (seat-in). Many of the inhabitants of the Uros islands still practice the old traditions of fishing and living on the lake plants. The narrow island of Taquile is home to numerous pre-Inca and Inca ruins and Inca terracing. Lunch included. Transfer to Juliaca and flight to Lima.

Day 9 Lima - Iguassú

Flight to Iguassú. The Iguazu falls are made up of 275 separate waterfalls, providing a sensational sight!

Day 10 Iguassú

Visit to the Argentinian side including the Devil's Throat with the highest continuous fall. In the afternoon continue to visit the Brazilian side with views of the full scale of the cascades.

Day 11 Iguassú - Buenos Aires

Flight to Buenos Aires. In the evening you will be taken to the tango house La Ventana, where you can opt between a tango lesson with specialized teachers or a wine tasting session of different Argentinean wines, followed by dinner with tango show.

Day 12 Buenos Aires

City tour through the "Paris" of South America. Visit the colourful La Boca district, famous May Square, modern Puerto Madero and beautiful Recoleta.

Day 13 Buenos Aires - Rio de Janeiro

Flight to Rio de Janeiro.

Day 14 Rio de Janeiro

Full day city tour including visit of the Sugar Loaf and the Corcovado. On optional basis you may visit a typical Samba Show featuring skilled dancers, samba bands and colourful costumes

Day 15 Rio de Janeiro

End of the roundtrip and homebound flight.
