


AGRICULTURAL PROGRAMS: POTATOE PARK

Take part of the Andean ritual "pago a la tierra" (Offering to the Earth). Despite this being an ancient ritual, it is still part of current Peruvian culture. The Potato Park is a new local model of agrobiodiversity conservation, a denominated Indigenous Biocultural Heritage Area. The Park is one of the 4 world's major food crops, protected for centuries by Andean people. The Potato Park celebrates the tremendous diversity of native potato varieties.







AGRICULTURAL PROGRAMS: AWANAKANCHA

Visit to Awanakancha, a living museum of Andean cameloids including Llamas, Alpacas, and the very rarely seen Vicuñas and Guanucos. Awanakancha's main task is the preservation of old weaving techniques, that are typical for the area, as well as support of the local communities involved in the project.
